Stand-Alone Continued Airworthiness Management Organisation

We will be seeking the additional EASA privileges to enable Mackenzie Morgan to issue Airworthiness Review Certificates.

We will not be aligned with any maintenance organisations. All decisions will be taken, based on airworthiness compliance and operator need.

Additionally, we will seek OTAR 39 approval from Bermuda, Cayman Islands and Turks and Caicos Islands, we see no reason why other operators should not take advantage of our innovation.

As a small independent business we are aware of cost and its impact on the organisation. We have adopted a philosophy of continuous improvement across the Company, and we will always seek to minimise cost at every opportunity. As part of our desire to minimise cost at every step, we will be adopting fleet management tools to reduce the number of times data is reviewed or commented on. We shall be announcing over the next few weeks a number of innovations that we believe will provide all operators with a flexible cost effective solution, which is tailored to need of the operator.

Operators will:

- Have access to their airworthiness data wherever and whenever they want it, through personalised user names and passwords;
- Have automated alerts when new data affecting their operation has been released and requires action on their part;
- Have access to annual audits of their maintenance provider;
- Have access to other supporting services as part of a larger fleet.

- The independence of your CAMO, from the needs of the maintenance organisation;
